What is CPD?

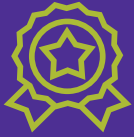

The Statutory Framework for the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) requires managers to support staff in completing relevant training. This continually improves learning and development experiences for children.



CPD requirements vary across different industries, depending on the nature of the work and individual job roles. From business (Association of Project Managers) to hospitality (Institute of Hospitality) to transport (Chartered Institute of Logistics and Transport), staff are expected to complete set numbers of CPD hours and points each year.
